

CONSTITUTION
of the
NORTH SHORE UNITARIAN CHURCH

ARTICLE I - NAME

This religious organization is incorporated under the name "NORTH SHORE UNITARIAN CHURCH" and is hereinafter referred to as the "Church".

ARTICLE II - OBJECTS

The objects of the Church are:

- (a) To establish, maintain and conduct a church to pursue the study and to practice the principles of Unitarianism which is an unending quest for, and defence of, the highest ideals of integrity in thought and conduct, combined with an endeavour by members of the Church to embody them in their own lives; and
- (b) To exist for religious, educational, moral and charitable purposes.

ARTICLE III - LOCATION

The objects of the Church shall be pursued chiefly in the City of North Vancouver, District of North Vancouver, Municipality of West Vancouver and Village of Lions Bay and their vicinity, being the area known as the North Shore, in the Province of British Columbia. This provision is alterable.
